WEEK ONE: PERSONAL / INDIVIDUAL PRAYER

DAY 1: PRAYER OF THANKSGIVING

1. Thanksgiving for Life and Grace – Thank God for His abundant grace, unfailing mercies, and enduring faithfulness that have preserved and sustained you. Thank Him for the gift of a new year, marked by divine favour, good news, and manifold benefits.

Lamentations 3:22-23 – “Through the Lord’s mercies we are not consumed, because His compassions fail not. They are new every morning; great is Your faithfulness.”

Psalms 103:1-5 – “Bless the Lord, O my soul; And all that is within me, bless His holy name! Bless the Lord, O my soul, and forget not all His benefits: Who forgives all your iniquities, Who heals all your diseases, Who redeems your life from destruction, Who crowns you with lovingkindness and tender mercies, Who satisfies your mouth with good things, so that your youth is renewed like the eagle’s.”

2. Thanksgiving for the Sufficiency of the Finished Work – Thank God for the inexhaustible sufficiency of the finished work of Christ, which grants us unfettered access to obtain by faith all that grace has provided in this season.

2 Corinthians 9:8 – “And God is able to make all grace abound toward you, that you, always having all sufficiency in all things, may have an abundance for every good work.”

Hebrews 4:16 – “Let us therefore come boldly to the

throne of grace, that we may obtain mercy and find grace to help in time of need.”

3. Grace for Supplication and Consecration – Receive strength and divine enablement for supplication and intercession throughout these 21 days and beyond. Ask for grace to remain unwavering in prayer and deeply rooted in His Word, seeking His face with tireless devotion.

Zechariah 12:10 – “And I will pour on the house of David and on the inhabitants of Jerusalem the Spirit of grace and supplication; then they will look on Me whom they pierced. Yes, they will mourn for Him as one mourns for his only son, and grieve for Him as one grieves for a firstborn.”

1 Thessalonians 5:16-18 – “Rejoice always, pray without ceasing, in everything give thanks; for this is the will of God in Christ Jesus for you.”

4. Thanksgiving for Past Victories – With a heart of gratitude, acknowledge God’s unfailing goodness for past victories. Give thanks that your faith yields forth greater manifestations, undeniable proofs of His presence, mighty wonders and a ceaseless flow of divine favor over your life in this season and beyond.

1 Corinthians 15:57 – “But thanks be to God, who gives us the victory through our Lord Jesus Christ.”

2 Corinthians 2:14 – “Now thanks be to God who always leads us in triumph in Christ, and through us diffuses the fragrance of His knowledge in every place.”

5. Silence the Noise, Hear the Voice of God – Pray for the grace to shut out distractions, silence every noisome pestilence, and tune your spirit to hear the still, small voice of God. Declare that in quietness and confidence, you receive divine instructions, clarity, and strength for the journey ahead.

Isaiah 30:15 (NKJV) – “For thus says the Lord God, the Holy One of Israel: ‘In returning and rest you shall be saved; in quietness and confidence shall be your strength.’”

Psalm 46:10 (NIV) – “Be still, and know that I am God; I will be exalted among the nations, I will be exalted in the earth.”

DAY 2: KNOWING GOD

1. A Deeper Hunger for and Revelation of God – Pray that your heart burns with an insatiable hunger for God’s presence and that you grow daily in the accurate knowledge of Him—in wisdom, revelation, and divine understanding, standing complete in His perfect will.

Psalm 42:1 – “As the deer pants for streams of water, so my soul pants for you, my God.”

John 17:3 – “And this is eternal life, that they may know You, the only true God, and Jesus Christ whom You have

sent.”

2. Spiritual Understanding and Discernment – Receive light: wisdom and revelation to rightly divide the word of truth, and insight to understand spiritual realities concerning your life and destiny.

Ephesians 1:17-18 – “That the God of our Lord Jesus Christ, the Father of glory, may give to you the spirit of wisdom and revelation in the knowledge of Him, the eyes of your understanding being enlightened. That you may know the hope of your calling.”

Colossians 1:9 – “For this reason we also, since the day we heard it, do not cease to pray for you, and to ask that you may be filled with the knowledge of His will in all wisdom and spiritual understanding.”

3. Walking in the Knowledge of God – Pray that as you walk deeper in the knowledge of God, your daily life will be an accurate reflection of His glory and power.

2 Peter 1:2-3 – “Grace and peace be multiplied to you in the knowledge of God and of Jesus our Lord, as His divine power has given to us all things that pertain to life and godliness, through the knowledge of Him who called us by glory and virtue.”

Colossians 2:6-7 – “As you therefore have received Christ Jesus the Lord, so walk in Him, rooted and built up in Him and established in the faith, as you have been taught, abounding in it with thanksgiving.”

4. Divine Direction Through Knowing God – Pray that through the precise knowledge of God, you will have clarity of purpose and divine direction in your life, daily.

Proverbs 3:5-6 – “Trust in the Lord with all your heart, and lean not on your own understanding; in all your ways acknowledge Him, and He shall direct your paths.”

Isaiah 30:21 – “Your ears shall hear a word behind you, saying, ‘This is the way, walk in it,’ whenever you turn to the right hand or whenever you turn to the left.”

Psalms 25:4-5 – “Show me Your ways, O Lord; Teach me Your paths. Lead me in Your truth and teach me, for You are the God of my salvation; on You I wait all the day.”

5. Recognizing and Acting on Divine Information – Pray for discernment to recognize the divine promptings and signals within. Declare that like Elijah, you will see what God is revealing, perceive His directions clearly, and act in obedience with unwavering conviction despite opposing circumstances. Insist that nothing will hinder you from stepping into your season of accelerated breakthrough.

Habakkuk 2:1 (NIV) – “I will stand at my watch and station myself on the ramparts; I will look to see what He will say to me, and what answer I am to give to this complaint.”

1 Kings 18:44-45 (MSG) – “ And sure enough, the seventh time he said, ‘Oh yes, a cloud! But very small, no bigger than someone’s hand, rising out of the sea.’ ‘Quickly then, on your way,’ said Elijah. ‘Tell Ahab, ‘Saddle up and

get down from the mountain before the rain stops you.” Things happened fast. The sky grew black with wind-driven clouds, and then a huge cloudburst of rain, with Ahab hightailing it in his chariot for Jezreel.”

DAY 3: FRUITFULNESS AND PRODUCTIVITY

1. Grace for Fruitfulness and Productivity – Pray that God’s commanded blessing of fruitfulness and productivity will manifest in every area of your life. Declare that you are inherently empowered to be fruitful and result-oriented in all you do.

Genesis 1:28 – “...Be fruitful, multiply, and fill the earth, and subdue it [putting it under your power]; and rule over [dominate] the fish of the sea, the birds of the air, and every living thing that moves upon the earth.”

Psalms 1:3 (AMP) – “And he will be like a tree firmly planted [and fed] by streams of water, which yields its fruit in its season; its leaf does not wither; and in whatever he does, he prospers [and comes to maturity].”

2. Dominion and Supernatural Expansion – Receive the divine enablement to govern your sphere of influence with wisdom, precision, and kingdom authority. Declare that you walk in the fullness of dominion, in every dimension of your life and assignment.

Luke 10:19 (TPT) – “Now you understand that I have imparted to you all my authority to trample over his kingdom. You will trample upon every demon before you and overcome every power Satan possesses. Absolutely nothing will harm you as you walk in this authority.”

Psalm 8:6 (NIV) – “You made them rulers over the works of your hands; you put everything under their feet.”

3. Productivity and Exponential Increase – Declare that because you carry your Heavenly Father’s DNA, you must and will produce results after His kind. You maximize opportunity, and create transformational impact in every sphere of your influence.

Genesis 1:28 (AMP) – “And God blessed them [granting them absolute authority] and said to them, ‘Be fruitful, multiply, and fill the earth, and subdue it [putting it under your power]; and rule over [dominate] the fish of the sea, the birds of the air, and every living thing that moves upon the earth.’”

Proverbs 4:18 (TPT) – “But the path of the righteous is like the light of dawn, shining brighter and brighter until full day.”

4. Confidence in God’s Ever-Present Supply – Declare that you walk daily in the consciousness of God’s unfailing presence, fully trusting in His inexhaustible supply and covenant faithfulness to a thousand generations. Declare that you will never lack, for the Lord sustains you.

Psalm 46:1 (NIV) – “God is our refuge and strength, an

ever-present help in trouble.”

Philippians 4:19 (NKJV) – “And my God shall supply all your need according to His riches in glory by Christ Jesus.”

5. Healing and Restoration – Declare that by the power of the finished work, you are healed of the wounds from past losses and restored from what was broken. Receive His grace to move forward with strength, knowing that He is the God of redemption who turns mourning into joy and ashes into beauty.

Joel 2:25 (NIV) – “I will repay you for the years the locusts have eaten—the great locust and the young locust, the other locusts and the locust swarm—my great army that I sent among you.”

Isaiah 61:3 (NKJV) – “To console those who mourn in Zion, to give them beauty for ashes, the oil of joy for mourning, the garment of praise for the spirit of heaviness; that they may be called trees of righteousness, the planting of the Lord, that He may be glorified.”

6. Recognizing the Power in What Remains – Pray that your eyes be opened to see the hidden value in what you have left. Declare that as you surrender your little into God’s hands, He will multiply it, breathe upon it, and bring forth increase beyond measure.

1 Kings 17:15-16 (NIV) – “She went away and did as Elijah had told her. So there was food every day for Elijah and for the woman and her family. For the jar of flour was not used

up and the jug of oil did not run dry, in keeping with the word of the Lord spoken by Elijah.”

2 Kings 4:2-4 (NIV) – “Elisha replied to her, ‘How can I help you? Tell me, what do you have in your house?’ ‘Your servant has nothing there at all,’ she said, ‘except a small jar of olive oil.’ Elisha said, ‘Go around and ask all your neighbors for empty jars. Don’t ask for just a few. Then go inside and shut the door behind you and your sons. Pour oil into all the jars, and as each is filled, put it to one side.’”

DAY 4: WALKING IN DIVINE PURPOSE & FULFILLING GOD’S MANDATE

1. Divine Alignment with God’s Purpose – Ask God for clarity of purpose, wisdom to align with His will, and the grace to fulfill all that is written concerning you.

Jeremiah 1:5 – “Before I formed you in the womb I knew you; Before you were born I sanctified you; I ordained you a prophet to the nations.”

Ephesians 2:10 – “For we are His workmanship, created in Christ Jesus for good works, which God prepared beforehand that we should walk in them.”

2. Divine Guidance and Clarity – Pray earnestly that the Almighty orders your steps with divine precision,

illuminates your path, and guides every decision you make to align with His perfect will.

Psalm 37:23 (AMP) – “The steps of a [good and righteous] man are directed and established by the Lord, and He delights in his way and blesses his path.”

Isaiah 30:21 (NIV) – “Whether you turn to the right or to the left, your ears will hear a voice behind you, saying, ‘This is the way; walk in it.’”

3. Rebuke Distractions and Stagnation – Take authority over every demonic distraction and hindrance designed to derail or delay you from fulfilling God’s mandate. Declare that you move forward with divine momentum, unhindered and unstoppable.

Hebrews 12:1-2 – “Let us lay aside every weight, and the sin which so easily ensnares us, and let us run with endurance the race that is set before us, looking unto Jesus, the author and finisher of our faith.”

Philippians 3:13-14 – “Brethren, I do not count myself to have apprehended; but one thing I do, forgetting those things which are behind and reaching forward to those things which are ahead, I press toward the goal for the prize of the upward call of God in Christ Jesus.”

4. A Hearing Ear and An Obedience Heart – Declare that you are endowed with the grace to discern God’s voice with unmistakable clarity, conviction, and confidence—above the noise of your circumstances; and your heart is swift to obey His word.

Isaiah 1:19 – “If you are willing and obedient, You shall eat the good of the land.”

John 10:27 (AMP) – “The sheep that are My own hear My voice and listen to Me; I know them, and they follow Me.”

5. Manifestation & Fulfillment of Destiny – prophetically declare that your whole live aligns with God’s blueprint, and you fulfill the divine mandate given you by God – with joy.

Jeremiah 29:11 (NIV) – “For I know the plans I have for you,” declares the Lord, “plans to prosper you and not to harm you, plans to give you a future and a hope.”

Ephesians 2:10 (AMP) – “For we are His workmanship [His own master work, a work of art], created in Christ Jesus [reborn from above—spiritually transformed, renewed, ready to be used] for good works, which God prepared [for us] beforehand [taking paths which He set], so that we would walk in them [living the good life which He prearranged and made ready for us].”

DAY 5: PRAYER FOR THE FAMILY

1. God’s Protection and Covering Over Families – Declare that every family is covered under the shadow of the Almighty, preserved from all evil and delivered from

demonic oppression.

Psalm 91:1-2 – “He who dwells in the secret place of the Most High shall abide under the shadow of the Almighty. I will say of the Lord, ‘He is my refuge and my fortress; My God, in Him I will trust.’”

Joshua 24:15 – “But as for me and my house, we will serve the Lord.”

2. Unity and Peace in Families – Pray and insist that love, harmony, and divine understanding govern every home. Decree strength, stability, and restoration in marriages, declaring that strife is silenced, and the spirit of divorce is rebuked. In Jesus’ Name, Amen!

Ephesians 4:31-32 – “Let all bitterness, wrath, anger, clamor, and evil speaking be put away from you, with all malice. And be kind to one another, tenderhearted, forgiving one another, even as God in Christ forgave you.”
 Psalm 133:1 – “Behold, how good and how pleasant it is for brethren to dwell together in unity!”

3. The In-Christ & Generational Blessing – By the authority of the finished work of Christ, boldly proclaim that you and your family walk in the fullness of your In-Christ reality. You are heirs of the blessing and walk in the liberty Christ has secured for you! The curse is broken!

Galatians 3:13-14 – “Christ has redeemed us from the curse of the law, having become a curse for us (for it is written, ‘Cursed is everyone who hangs on a tree’), that the blessing of Abraham might come upon the Gentiles

in Christ Jesus, that we might receive the promise of the Spirit through faith.”

Isaiah 61:4 – “And they shall rebuild the old ruins, they shall raise up the former desolations, and they shall repair the ruined cities, the desolations of many generations.”

4. Salvation of Family Members – Pray that every unsaved family member encounter Christ and surrenders to His Lordship. Declare that by the grace of God that brings salvation, your household is redeemed, and walk in the fullness of all that accompanies salvation.

Titus 2:11 (NIV) – “For the grace of God has appeared that offers salvation to all people.”

Acts 16:31 – “So they said, ‘Believe on the Lord Jesus Christ, and you will be saved, you and your household.’”

5. Multiplication and Divine Increase – Pray for supernatural increase in every dimension of your life, work, and destiny. Declare fruitfulness for the barren, promotion on the job, progress and increase in your business, career, education, family, and ministry, you flourish and prosper beyond limitations, as you walk with God.

Isaiah 54:2-3 (MSG) – “Clear lots of ground for your tents! Make your tents large. Spread out! Think big! Use plenty of rope, drive the tent pegs deep. You’re going to need lots of elbow room for your growing family.”

Deuteronomy 28:11 (TLB) – “And the Lord will give you an abundance of good things in the land, just as he

promised—many children, many cattle, and abundant crops.”

DAY 6: PRAYER FOR HEALTH, HEALING, AND WHOLENESS

1. Divine Health and Strength – Decree and declare that our spirit, soul, and body flourish in divine health and strength. We and our family walk in supernatural health and strength, prospering in all things, and remain for signs and wonders through many generations.

Isaiah 8:18 (NKJV) – “Here am I and the children whom the Lord has given me! We are for signs and wonders in Israel from the Lord of hosts, Who dwells in Mount Zion.”

3 John 1:2 – “Beloved, I pray that you may prosper in all things and be in health, just as your soul prospers.”

2. Healing and Wholeness – Declare in faith that your body is strong and immune to sicknesses and diseases. Rebuke every recalcitrant and recurring affliction, declaring divine healing over our bodies. By the power of the anointing, every yoke of sickness and disease is destroyed, and our families walk in divine health, wholeness, and the fullness of God’s covenant of life.

Isaiah 53:5 – “But He was wounded for our transgressions, He was bruised for our iniquities; the chastisement for our peace was upon Him, and by His stripes we are healed.”

Psalm 107:20 – “He sent His word and healed them, and delivered them from their destructions.”

3. Mental Health and Emotional Healing – Decree and declare that anxiety, depression, and every form of mental distress are shattered by the power of God. We declare healing, peace, and soundness of mind, for our families.

Philippians 4:6-7 – “Be anxious for nothing, but in everything by prayer and supplication, with thanksgiving, let your requests be made known to God; and the peace of God, which surpasses all understanding, will guard your hearts and minds through Christ Jesus.”

2 Timothy 1:7 – “For God has not given us a spirit of fear, but of power and of love and of a sound mind.”

Psalm 34:17-18 – “The righteous cry out, and the Lord hears, and delivers them out of all their troubles. The Lord is near to those who have a broken heart and saves such as have a contrite spirit.”

4. Supernatural Restoration and Recovery – Decree and declare that every loss—in health, strength, or vitality—is supernaturally restored. Prophecy divine recovery of lost years, accelerated renewal, and a complete restoration with compensation of all that was stolen or lost.

Joel 2:25-26 – “So I will restore to you the years that the swarming locust has eaten, the crawling locust, the consuming locust, and the chewing locust, My great army

which I sent among you. You shall eat in plenty and be satisfied, and praise the name of the Lord your God, who has dealt wondrously with you.”

Psalm 103:2-5 – “Bless the Lord, O my soul, and forget not all His benefits: Who forgives all your iniquities, Who heals all your diseases, Who redeems your life from destruction, Who crowns you with lovingkindness and tender mercies, Who satisfies your mouth with good things, so that your youth is renewed like the eagle’s.”

5. Long Life and Vitality – Decree and declare that you live long in divine health, strength, and wealth, fulfilling our God-ordained assignments with grace and passion, flourishing in every season of life. In Jesus’ Name, Amen!

Psalm 91:16 – “With long life I will satisfy him, and show him My salvation.”

Deuteronomy 34:7 – “Moses was one hundred and twenty years old when he died. His eyes were not dim nor his natural vigor diminished.”

DAY 7: PRAYER FOR BUSINESSES, CAREER, AND VOCATION

1. Supernatural Prosperity in Business and Career – Decree that the work of your hand is blessed, and we walk in financial prosperity in our career and business.

Deuteronomy 28:12 – “The Lord will open to you His good treasure, the heavens, to give the rain to your land in its season, and to bless all the work of your hand. You shall lend to many nations, but you shall not borrow.”

Psalm 90:17 – “And let the beauty of the Lord our God be upon us, and establish the work of our hands for us; Yes, establish the work of our hands.”

2. Career and Business Limitations – We rebuke stagnation, loss, delays, and break every limitation over our career, business, ministry and personal economy. We declare growth in all aspects, in Jesus Name. Amen!

Isaiah 48:17 – “Thus says the Lord, your Redeemer, the Holy One of Israel: ‘I am the Lord your God, who teaches you to profit, who leads you by the way you should go.’”

Proverbs 22:29 – “Do you see a man who excels in his work? He will stand before kings; He will not stand before unknown men.”

3. Divine Connections and Favor in Vocation – Vehemently declare that doors of opportunity open of their own accord before you. Pray that the Lord orders your steps to the right soil, where you will take root, nurture, and bear fruit. Declare that your help has come, and God sends you destiny facilitators, covenant partners, and men of goodwill to propel you into purpose. In Jesus’ Name, Amen!

Psalm 5:12 – “For You, O Lord, will bless the righteous;

with favor You will surround him as with a shield.”

Psalm 37:23 (NKJV) – “The steps of a good man are ordered by the Lord, and He delights in his way.”

4. Excellence in Career and Education – Declare that the spirit of excellence rests upon our students, professionals, and scholars. Like Daniel and the Hebrew boys, they operate in superior wisdom, knowledge, and skill, standing out ten times better than their peers. They excel in their pursuits and fulfill their divine mandate with distinction.

Daniel 1:17, 20 (NKJV) – “As for these four young men, God gave them knowledge and skill in all literature and wisdom; and Daniel had understanding in all visions and dreams... And in all matters of wisdom and understanding about which the king examined them, he found them ten times better than all the magicians and astrologers who were in all his realm.”

Proverbs 22:29 (NKJV) – “Do you see a man who excels in his work? He will stand before kings; He will not stand before unknown men.”

5. Wealth Transfer and Financial Dominion – We insist that by the supernatural workings of God, we walk in uncommon favor. Wealth is divinely transferred into our hands, resources locate us effortlessly, and we steward God’s abundant resources with wisdom, integrity, and kingdom purpose.

2 Corinthians 9:8 – “And God is able to make all grace abound toward you, that you, always having all sufficiency

in all things, may have an abundance for every good work.”

Isaiah 61:6-7 – “But you shall be named the priests of the Lord, they shall call you the servants of our God. You shall eat the riches of the Gentiles, and in their glory you shall boast. Instead of your shame you shall have double honor, and instead of confusion they shall rejoice in their portion. Therefore, in their land they shall possess double; everlasting joy shall be theirs.”

WEEK TWO: NATIONAL PRAYER DAY 8: PRAYER FOR THE NATION THE ADMINISTRATION

1. Thanksgiving and Prophetic Declaration Over Nigeria – With hearts full of gratitude, thank God for our great nation, Nigeria, chosen by God as an apostolic hub for His end-time agenda. Joyfully declare that the day of His divine visitation draws near—it will not delay, detour, or be denied. The kingdom of God is established, His will prevails, and Nigeria rises as a beacon of righteousness, peace, and divine purpose.

Psalm 33:12 (NIV) – “Blessed is the nation whose God is the Lord, the people He chose for His inheritance.”

2. The President and Leadership of Nigeria – Intercede for the President of the Federal Republic of Nigeria, his cabinet, the three arms of government (Executive, Legislature, and Judiciary), and the four tiers of governance (Federal, State, Local Government, and Wards). Declare that they come under divine influence and yield to the authority of God. Proclaim that they govern with wisdom, righteousness, and integrity, aligning every decision with God’s divine agenda for the nation.

Proverbs 21:1 (NIV) – “In the Lord’s hand the king’s heart is a stream of water that He channels toward all who please Him.”

1 Timothy 2:1-2 (NKJV) – “Therefore I exhort first of all that supplications, prayers, intercessions, and giving of thanks be made for all men, for kings and all who are in authority, that we may lead a quiet and peaceable life in all godliness and reverence.”

Psalm 91:1-2 (NKJV) – “He who dwells in the secret place of the Most High shall abide under the shadow of the Almighty. I will say of the Lord, ‘He is my refuge and my fortress; My God, in Him I will trust.’”

Psalm 31:20 (NKJV) – “You shall hide them in the secret place of Your presence from the plots of man; You shall keep them secretly in a pavilion from the strife of tongues.”

2. WEEK THREE: CORPORATE PRAYER

DAY 15: PRAYER FOR HOUSE ON THE ROCK: THANKSGIVING FOR HOUSE ON THE ROCK

1. Thanksgiving for House On The Rock – Thank God for establishing House On The Rock as a Voice of Excellence, a Hand of His Power, and a Bridge of Hope to this generation. Bless the Lord for the life of His son and servant, Pastor Paul Adefarasin, the set man over this great Commission.

Psalm 100:3-4 (NKJV) – “Know that the Lord, He is God; It is He who has made us, and not we ourselves; We are His people and the sheep of His pasture. Enter into His gates with thanksgiving, and into His courts with praise. Be thankful to Him, and bless His name.”

Psalm 118:23-24 (NKJV) – “This was the Lord’s doing; It is marvelous in our eyes. This is the day the Lord has made; We will rejoice and be glad in it.”

2. Thanksgiving for The Set Man & Exceptional Leadership – Honor God for raising an extraordinary leader and visionary, Pastor Paul Adefarasin, through whom the kingdom of God is being advanced across various spheres of influence. Thank God for His wisdom, strength, and divine enablement upon His servant, empowering him to lead with insight, excellence, and purpose.

1 Kings 3:9 (KJV) – “Give therefore thy servant an understanding heart to judge thy people, that I may discern between good and bad: for who is able to judge this thy so great a people?”

Psalm 89:20-21 (NKJV) – “I have found My servant David; with My holy oil I have anointed him. With whom My hand shall be established; also My arm shall strengthen him.”

3. Thanksgiving for Manifold Grace – Bless the Lord for His abundant grace upon All House On The Rock. Celebrate with thanksgiving 30 years of remarkable exploits, undeniable impact, and supernatural advancement, as the grace of God continues to propel the vision to new heights.

1 Timothy 1:14 (NKJV) – “And the grace of our Lord was exceedingly abundant, with faith and love which are in Christ Jesus.”

1 Corinthians 15:10 (NKJV) – “But by the grace of God I am what I am, and His grace toward me was not in vain; but I labored more abundantly than they all, yet not I, but the grace of God which was with me.”

4. New Spheres of Influence and Dominion – We declare that House On The Rock rises to new spheres of influence, power and kingdom advancement, as a beacon of hope, justice and national transformation. Bless the Lord for His abundant grace upon All House On The Rock. Celebrate with

Haggai 2:9 (NKJV) – “The glory of this latter temple shall be greater than the former,’ says the Lord of hosts. ‘And in this place, I will give peace,’ says the Lord of hosts.”

Proverbs 4:18 (NIV) – “The path of the righteous is like the

morning sun, shining ever brighter till the full light of day.”

5. A Vanguard for National Transformation – Declare that House On The Rock remains a vanguard for national transformation, raising for righteousness, governance, and societal reformation. Decree that through her apostolic influence, Nigeria is repositioned, rebranded and rebuilt as the nation whose Builder and Maker is the Lord.

Isaiah 58:12 (NKJV) – “Those from among you shall build the old waste places; You shall raise up the foundations of many generations; And you shall be called the Repairer of the Breach, The Restorer of Streets to Dwell In.”

Hebrews 11:10 (NIV) – “For he was looking forward to the city with foundations, whose architect and builder is God.”

DAY 16 – PRAYER FOR HOUSE ON THE ROCK: GROWTH AND EXPANSION

1. Global Expansion and Kingdom Impact – Pray for the growth and expansion of House On The Rock expressions across the globe—in cities, nations, and institutions of higher learning. Decree that House On The Rock remains at the cutting edge of ministry as a fountainhead of fresh revival, innovation, and reformation, raising leaders, shaping minds, and transforming nations for Christ.

Genesis 49:22 – “Joseph is a fruitful bough, a fruitful bough by a well; his branches run over the wall.”

Isaiah 54:2-3 (NKJV) – “Enlarge the place of your tent, and let them stretch out the curtains of your dwellings; do not spare; lengthen your cords, and strengthen your stakes. For you shall expand to the right and to the left, and your descendants will inherit the nations, and make the desolate cities inhabited.”

2. Conferences & Events – Declare that in 2025, every conference and event hosted by House On The Rock—Word Conference, Spirit Life Conference, T.A.P.E., and The Experience Concert—will be marked by the Spirit of Excellence and the full expression of the sevenfold Spirit of God. Decree that signs, wonders, and undeniable miracles shall be wrought through the mighty Name of our Lord Jesus Christ, transforming lives and shifting destinies.

Isaiah 11:2 (NKJV) – “The Spirit of the Lord shall rest upon Him, the Spirit of wisdom and understanding, the Spirit of counsel and might, the Spirit of knowledge and of the fear of the Lord.”

Acts 2:22 (NIV) – “Fellow Israelites, listen to this: Jesus of Nazareth was a man accredited by God to you by miracles, wonders and signs, which God did among you through him, as you yourselves know.”

3. Laborers for the Harvest and Kingdom Expansion – Pray that the Lord of the harvest sends forth faithful and able men and women into His vineyard. Call forth men and women of like minds and passion, who will serve selflessly, and run with the vision with divine precision.

2 Timothy 2:2 (NIV) – “ And the things that thou hast heard of me among many witnesses, the same commit thou to faithful men, who shall be able to teach others also.

Habakuk 2:2 (CEV) – Then the Lord told me: ‘I will give you my message in the form of a vision. Write it clearly enough to be read at a glance. At the time I have decided, my words will come true. You can trust what I say about the future. It may take a long time, but keep on waiting—it will happen!’”

4. Quantitative and Qualitative Growth – We declare that House On The Rock experiences exponential growth—numerically and spiritually—abounding in grace, sound doctrine, and kingdom influence. We insist that multitudes from every sphere of life are drawn into this House, planted, and established in the faith. We take authority over every hindrance to growth and expansion, releasing supernatural acceleration, divine favor, and open doors in every city, nation, and institution of higher learning. In Jesus’ Name, Amen!

Acts 2:47 (NIV) – “And the Lord added to their number daily those who were being saved.”

Isaiah 60:22 (NIV) – “The least of you will become a thousand, the smallest a mighty nation. I am the Lord; in its time I will do this swiftly.”

5. Supernatural Harvest of Souls – Intercede and call forth a mighty harvest of souls within House On The Rock. Decree that multitudes are drawn into the kingdom, deeply rooted in Christ, and established in faith, wisdom, and purpose.

Declare that they grow in grace, becoming effective ambassadors of the Gospel, bearing lasting fruit for God's glory.

Matthew 9:37-38 (NKJV) – "Then He said to His disciples, 'The harvest truly is plentiful, but the laborers are few. Therefore pray the Lord of the harvest to send out laborers into His harvest.'"

Acts 2:47 (NIV) – "And the Lord added to their number daily those who were being saved."

DAY 17 – PRAYER FOR HOUSE ON THE ROCK PRAYER FOR CHURCH LEADERSHIP

1. Fresh Anointing and Divine Enablement – Pray for a grace and fresh anointing upon the Metropolitan Senior Pastor and the leadership of House On The Rock. Declare that the power and grace of the Lord rest mightily upon them, as the ministry grows into new frontiers.

Psalms 89:20 (NKJV) – "I have found My servant David; with My holy oil I have anointed him."

Isaiah 61:1 (NKJV) – "The Spirit of the Lord God is upon Me, because the Lord has anointed Me to preach good tidings to the poor; He has sent Me to heal the brokenhearted, to proclaim liberty to the captives, and the opening of the prison to those who are bound."

2. Outpouring of the Spirit and Renewed Strength – Ask God to pour out His Spirit upon the leadership in a ceaseless flow. Decree fresh zeal, divine wisdom, renewed strength, and unwavering focus upon the Pastors and leaders as they serve God’s purpose.

Isaiah 11:2-3 (NKJV) – “The Spirit of the Lord shall rest upon Him, the Spirit of wisdom and understanding, the Spirit of counsel and might, the Spirit of knowledge and of the fear of the Lord.”

Zechariah 4:6 (NKJV) – “Not by might nor by power, but by My Spirit,” says the Lord of hosts.

3. Divine Protection and Supernatural Preservation – Ask God to cover, protect, and keep the entire leadership of House On The Rock from harm. Decree that they are shielded from every attack of the enemy, standing strong in divine safety and preservation.

Zechariah 12:8 (NKJV) – “In that day the Lord will defend the inhabitants of Jerusalem; the one who is feeble among them in that day shall be like David, and the house of David shall be like God, like the Angel of the Lord before them.”

Psalms 125:2 (NIV) – “As the mountains surround Jerusalem, so the Lord surrounds His people both now and forevermore.”

4. Unity and Focus in Leadership – Insist that the leadership of House On The Rock remains united in spirit, doctrine, and purpose. Declare that no division or discord will disrupt

the synergy of leaders, and that they function as a strong, unbreakable force under the commanded blessing of God.

Joel 2:7-8 (NKJV) – “They shall run like mighty men, they shall climb the wall like men of war; everyone marches in formation, and they do not break ranks.”

Psalm 133:1 (NKJV) – “Behold, how good and how pleasant it is for brethren to dwell together in unity!”

5. Alignment with and Commitment to the Vision– Pray that every leader, Directorate and Department in House On The Rock remains connected to and aligned with the vision, values, and doctrine of this apostolic House. Insist that they walk in the spirit of excellence, loyalty, and integrity, deeply committed to the work of the ministry. Release the commanded blessing upon the leadership structure, the Workforce and their households, that they flourish and abound in every good work.

Numbers 11:16-17 (NKJV) – “I will take of the Spirit that is upon you and will put the same upon them; and they shall bear the burden of the people with you, that you may not bear it yourself alone.”

Psalm 133:1-3 (NIV) – “How good and pleasant it is when God’s people live together in unity! ... For there the Lord bestows his blessing, even life forevermore.”

DAY 18 – PRAYER FOR HOUSE ON THE ROCK: BRANCH PASTORS AND DAUGHTER CHURCHES

1. Flourishing of the Vision in Every City and Region – Pray that the vision and mission of House On The Rock flourish in every city, region, and nation where it is planted.

Isaiah 55:11 (NKJV) – “So shall My word be that goes forth from My mouth; it shall not return to Me void, but it shall accomplish what I please, and it shall prosper in the thing for which I sent it.”

Jeremiah 30:19 (TPT) – “ “From them will flow songs of praise and the sounds of rejoicing! I will increase their numbers, and they will not dwindle. I will honor them, and they will not be insignificant.”

2. Alignment and Fruitfulness of Daughter Churches – Declare that every House On The Rock daughter church stay deeply rooted with the vision and mandate of the visionary. Decree that each branch pastor and congregation seamlessly align with the evolving frontiers of the ministry, advancing the kingdom, making transformational impact and bearing lasting fruit in their city of assignment.

John 15:4-5 (NKJV) – “Abide in Me, and I in you. As the branch cannot bear fruit of itself, unless it abides in the vine, neither can you, unless you abide in Me. I am the vine, you are the branches. He who abides in Me, and I in him, bears much fruit; for without Me you can do nothing.”

1 Corinthians 3:6-7 (KJV) – “I have planted, Apollos watered; but God gave the increase. So then neither is he that planteth any thing, neither he that watereth; but God that giveth the increase.”

3. Breaking Every Opposition Against Growth – Bind every force of darkness assigned to hinder the progress of the vision in all House On The Rock daughter churches and ministry expressions. Decree divine intervention and supernatural help from the presence of God, ensuring unhindered expansion and lasting impact.

Matthew 16:18 (NKJV) – “And I also say to you that you are Peter, and on this rock I will build My church, and the gates of Hades shall not prevail against it.”

Isaiah 54:17 (NKJV) – “No weapon formed against you shall prosper, and every tongue which rises against you in judgment you shall condemn.”

4. New Frontiers and Greater Exploits – Decree that all House On The Rock churches advance into new frontiers, breaking barriers and pioneering unprecedented exploits for God’s glory. Unlock strategic and effectual doors of ministry in nations, cities and institutions. Decree supernatural wisdom, divine strategies, uncommon favor, human capital, abundant resources and divine help to fulfill the mandate without fail.

Deuteronomy 11:24 (NIV) – “Every place where you set your foot will be yours: Your territory will extend from the desert to Lebanon, and from the Euphrates River to the Mediterranean Sea.”

Daniel 11:32b (KJV) – “But the people that do know their God shall be strong, and do exploits.”

5. God’s Manifold and Exceeding Grace – Declare that the manifold and exceeding grace of God is clearly and richly demonstrated in every House On The Rock expression and ministry. No aspect of her assignment will be deficient in grace, or suffer loss, but that she thrives in the fullness of God’s all-sufficient grace.

2 Corinthians 9:8 (KJV) – “And God is able to make all grace abound toward you; that ye, always having all sufficiency in all things, may abound to every good work.”

1 Peter 4:10 (NIV) – “Each of you should use whatever gift you have received to serve others, as faithful stewards of God’s grace in its various forms.”

6. Divine Establishment and Preservation – Ask the Lord to establish, build, guard, defend and preserve All House On The Rock. Decree that every leader and parishioner are shielded under God’s mighty hand, and the work of the ministry flourishes without restraint or hinderance.

Psalms 127:1 (NKJV) – “Unless the Lord builds the house, they labor in vain who build it; unless the Lord guards the city, the watchman stays awake in vain.”

2 Thessalonians 3:3 (NIV) – “But the Lord is faithful, and He will strengthen you and protect you from the evil one.”

DAY 19 – PRAYER FOR THE BODY OF CHRIST

1. Unity of the Body – Pray for the leadership of the global Church to come together in unity and purpose, manifesting the knowledge of Christ in every place, preparing and making ready the Bride of Christ, especially, as we see the Day approaching.

Psalm 133:1-3

Behold, how good and how pleasant it is
For brethren to dwell together in unity!
It is like the precious ointment upon the head,
That ran down upon the beard, even Aaron's beard:
That went down to the skirts of his garments;
As the dew of Hermon, and as the dew that descended upon the mountains of Zion:
For there the Lord commanded the blessing,
Even life for evermore.

Ephesians 4:3

Make every effort to keep the unity of the Spirit through the bond of peace.

2. Relevance and Effectiveness of the Church – Pray that the Body of Jesus Christ, will remain relevant in every generation, fully accomplishing her assignment in the earth with great grace, zeal and ease from God the Father, with maximum outcome.

Psalm 69:9

For the zeal of thine house hath eaten me up;
and the reproaches of them that reproached thee
are fallen upon me.

Isaiah 9:7

Of the increase of his government and peace there shall be no end, upon the throne of David, and upon his kingdom, to order it, and to establish it with judgment and with justice from henceforth even forever. The zeal of the LORD of hosts will perform this.

3. Fulfilling Our Roles in the Body of Christ – Pray that every individual in the Body of Christ, will comprehend intelligently their various gifts and role in the Body, maximize it and effectively fulfil it, to the glory of God’s grace and for the benefit of humanity.

Ephesians 1:17 (MSG)

I ask - ask the God of our Master, Jesus Christ, the God of glory - to make you intelligent and discerning in knowing him personally, your eyes focused and clear, so that you can see exactly what it is he is calling you to do, grasp the immensity of this glorious way of life he has for his followers, oh, the utter extravagance of his work in us who trust him - endless energy, boundless strength!

Colossians 4:17

And say to Archippus, Take heed to the ministry which thou hast received in the Lord, that thou fulfil it.

4. Restrain the Force of Ungodliness – Rebuke and restrain every force of ungodliness assigned to hinder the progress of the Church. Silence the voices of deception, false doctrines, apostasy, and every anti-Christ agenda. Decree that the Church of Jesus Christ remains steadfast in truth and sound doctrine, unshaken in faith, advancing the pure gospel to the ends of the earth.

2 Timothy 4:3-4 (KJV) – “For the time will come when they will not endure sound doctrine; but after their own lusts shall they heap to themselves teachers, having itching ears; And they shall turn away their ears from the truth, and shall be turned unto fables.”

2 Thessalonians 2:5-8 – “Don’t you remember me warning you about all this when I was still with you? You know what’s holding him back until it’s time for him to come forward. The Antichrist doesn’t have free rein at this moment. How much longer? Only God knows. But the time will come when he’s out of the way. And then the Evil One will be revealed: the one whom the Master Jesus will sweep away with the breath of his mouth and bring to nothing by his dazzling presence.”

5. Strength for the Persecuted Church & Global Revival – Intercede for believers facing persecution and martyrdom worldwide, especially in Nigeria and other afflicted nations. Declare supernatural protection, unshaken strength, divine deliverance, and salvation for their persecutors. Decree that in the face of persecution, the Church advances in power with undeniable demonstrations of the Spirit, igniting global revival and kingdom expansion.

2 Timothy 3:12 (KJV) – “Yea, and all that will live godly in Christ Jesus shall suffer persecution.”

Acts 4:29-30 (NKJV) – “Now, Lord, look on their threats, and grant to Your servants that with all boldness they may speak Your word, by stretching out Your hand to heal, and

that signs and wonders may be done through the name of Your holy Servant Jesus.”

DAY 20 – PRAYER FOR PASTOR PAUL

1. Thanksgiving for God’s Grace and Goodness – Give thanks for the immeasurable love, unfailing goodness, and exceeding grace of God upon His son and servant, Pastor Paul, over the past four decades in ministry. Celebrate God’s faithfulness in preserving, guiding, and anointing him for this generation.

2 Corinthians 9:14-15 (NIV) – “And their prayers for you will express their affection for you, because of the surpassing grace God has given you. Thanks be to God for His indescribable gift!”

Philippians 1:2-4 (NIV) – “Grace and peace to you from God our Father and the Lord Jesus Christ. I thank my God every time I remember you. In all my prayers for all of you, I always pray with joy.”

2. Fresh Anointing and Strength for New Levels – Declare a fresh anointing and divine strength upon Pastor Paul as he takes on more roles and higher dimensions of his apostolic calling. Decree that he moves in greater grace, wisdom, and kingdom influence, navigating every assignment with clarity and supernatural ease. Declare that he fulfills his mandate with excellence and finishes strong, in Jesus’

Name, Amen!

Isaiah 42:9 (NKJV) – “Behold, the former things have come to pass, and new things I declare; before they spring forth I tell you of them.”

2 Corinthians 9:8 (NIV) – “And God is able to bless you abundantly, so that in all things at all times, having all that you need, you will abound in every good work.”

3. A Season of Harvest and Divine Reward – Declare that Pastor Paul and the entire Ministry steps into an unending season of divine harvest, abundant grace and divine compensation for their labor of love and steadfast commitment to God’s purpose. They are rewarded by both God and man for their diligence in and commitment to the Kingdom.

Genesis 15:1 (NKJV) – “After these things the word of the Lord came to Abram in a vision, saying, ‘Do not be afraid, Abram. I am your shield, your exceedingly great reward.’”

Hebrews 6:10 (KJV) – “For God is not unrighteous to forget your work and labor of love, which ye have shown toward His name, in that ye have ministered to the saints, and do minister.”

2 Timothy 2:6 (KJV) – “The hardworking farmer must be first to partake of the crops.”

4. A Voice of Wisdom to the Nations – Pray that Pastor Paul remains a voice of divine wisdom, a bridge of hope,

collaborator and a unifier, especially in this dispensation in Nigeria. Declare that his voice will remain relevant, cutting through the noise of the age with divine insight and solutions.

Isaiah 40:3 (NKJV) – “The voice of one crying in the wilderness: ‘Prepare the way of the Lord; Make straight in the desert a highway for our God.’”

Malachi 3:1 (KJV) – “Behold, I will send My messenger, and he shall prepare the way before Me: and the Lord, whom ye seek, shall suddenly come to His temple, even the Messenger of the covenant, whom ye delight in: behold, He shall come, saith the Lord of hosts.”

5. Divine Protection and Preservation – Declare that by the mighty hand of God, Pastor Paul and his family are supernaturally protected, delivered from wicked and unreasonable men. Decree that they are kept from every secret plot, hidden snare, and demonic conspiracy. Ask God to lift them above all adversaries, preserving them in peace, health, strength, and long life.

2 Thessalonians 3:2 (KJV) – “And that we may be delivered from unreasonable and wicked men: for all men have not faith.”

Psalms 31:20 (NKJV) – “You shall hide them in the secret place of Your presence from the plots of man; You shall keep them secretly in a pavilion from the strife of tongues.”

DAY 21 – THANKSGIVING FOR ANSWERED PRAYERS WITH ABUNDANT TESTIMONIES

1. Thanksgiving for Answered Prayers – Thank God that He has heard and answered every prayer made in this season of PUSH, and we step into new seasons and new levels of manifestations of God’s goodness and glory.

1 John 5:14-15 (NKJV) – “Now this is the confidence that we have in Him, that if we ask anything according to His will, He hears us. And if we know that He hears us, whatever we ask, we know that we have the petitions that we have asked of Him.”

Psalms 66:19-20 (NKJV) – “But certainly God has heard me; He has attended to the voice of my prayer. Blessed be God, who has not turned away my prayer, nor His mercy from me!”

2. No Delay & Abundant Testimonies – Rebuke every attempt of the enemy to delay or deny the manifestation of answers to our prayers. We insist that every prayer made is established and will manifest speedily in due time as we wait in faith and patience.

Daniel 10:12-13 (NKJV) – “Then he said to me, ‘Do not fear, Daniel, for from the first day that you set your heart to understand, and to humble yourself before your God, your words were heard; and I have come because of your words. But the prince of the kingdom of Persia withstood me twenty-one days.’”

Habakkuk 2:3 (NKJV) – “For the vision is yet for an appointed time; But at the end it will speak, and it will not lie. Though it tarries, wait for it; Because it will surely come, It will not tarry.”

3. PUSH Will Birth Greater Dimensions of God’s Glory – Decree that what God has started will continue to grow and bear much fruit. We declare that through this season of PUSH, irrefutable testimonies will abound, drawing multitudes to Christ.

Philippians 1:6 (NKJV) – “Being confident of this very thing, that He who has begun a good work in you will complete it until the day of Jesus Christ.”

Ephesians 3:20-21 (NKJV) – “Now to Him who is able to do exceedingly abundantly above all that we ask or think, according to the power that works in us, to Him be glory in the church by Christ Jesus to all generations, forever and ever. Amen.”
